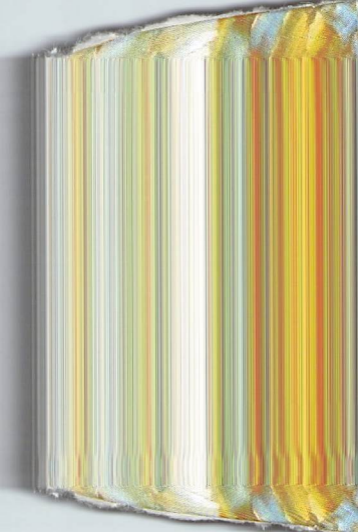
Dear Bruce and family,
