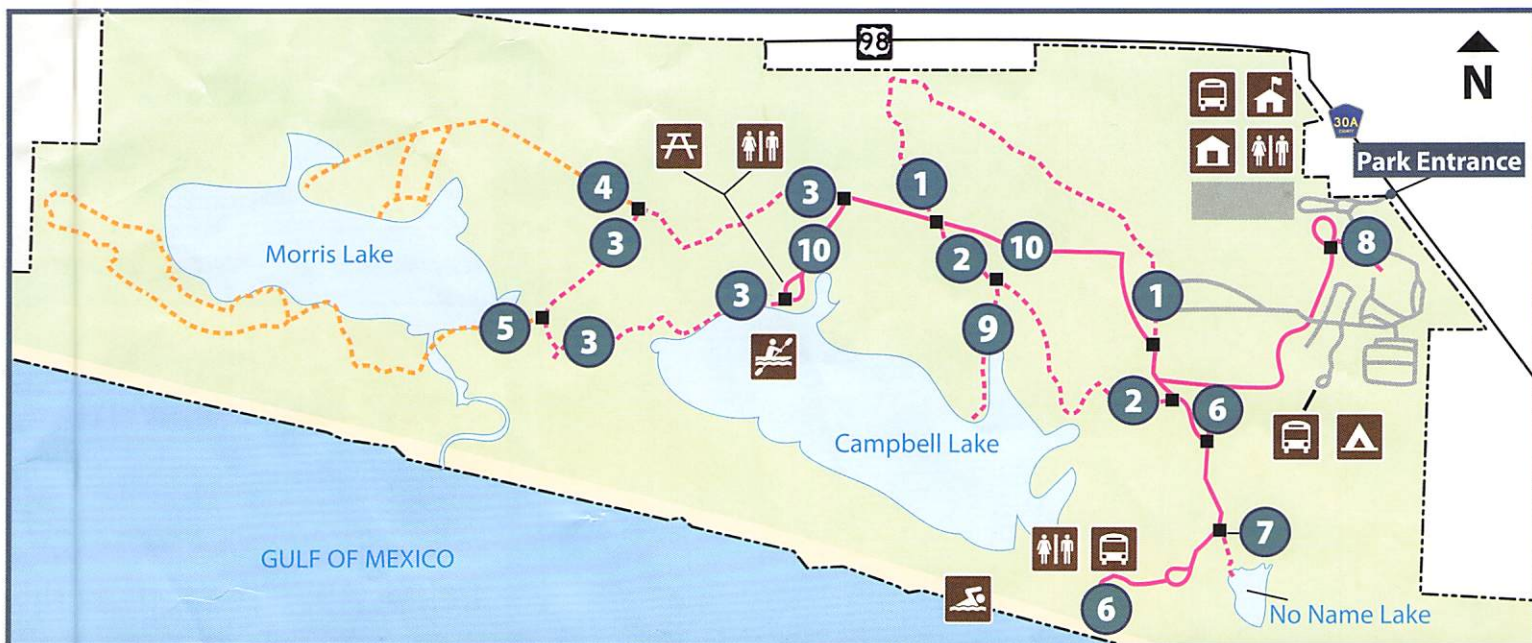

Park Information

- Park hours are 8 a.m. to sunset, 365 days a year.
- Speed limited in the park is 10 mph.
- When entering the park, all campers and guests must stop at the ranger station window.
- Bicyclists must obey all traffic laws. Florida law requires all children under age 16 to wear a helmet while bicycling.
- Display your parking pass in your vehicle's windshield.
- One RV unit and one vehicle per site. The maximum is eight people per site. Parking areas are provided for additional vehicles.
- Open ground fires are not allowed. RV campers may bring an above ground fire ring and tent sites may use the fire rings provided.
- Alcohol is permitted on your campsite only.
- All motorized vehicles, including electric, must have a licensed driver and must be street legal.
- Do not stake anything to the ground due to underground utilities.
- RVs, vehicles and boats may not be washed in the park.
- It is unlawful to remove, destroy, deface or dig on park property. Do not attach ropes, clotheslines or anything else to trees in the park.
- Trash must be placed in dumpsters. Recycling is collected next to each dumpster.
- Leave no trace. Items cannot be left on the beach overnight. They will be removed.
- Before plugging into the electrical pedestal, verify that the breaker is switched to the OFF position. This will protect the pedestal and your equipment. Once the power cord is firmly plugged in, switch the breaker ON. Do not remove the backflow preventer attached to the water spigot.
- Pets are permitted in designated areas only. They are not allowed in buildings, cabins, on boardwalks or on the beach.
- Pets must be on a six-foot, hand-held leash and well behaved. Pets must not be left unattended for more than 30 minutes. Please pick up after pets and dispose of all pet droppings in trash receptacles.
